

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

The Board of Supervisors of Burt County, Nebraska will receive sealed bids for .53 miles of full depth asphalt and aggregate base patching with aggregate base drainage structures construction on June 13th, at 10:00am 2017 in the courthouse at Tekamah, Nebraska. Project location: County road RS west of Lyons, Ne. From one Sta. west of Co. Rd. 7 and Co. Rd. RS east .53 miles.

The contract documents and specifications are on file and may be obtained at the office of the County Highway Superintendent located at 111 N 13th St Suite 3, Tekamah, Nebraska (402-374-2944).

Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check drawn on a solvent bank in an amount of no less than five percent of the bid amount of construction costs, and shall be made payable to the County Clerk of the County of Burt, Nebraska as security that the bidder to whom the contract may be awarded will enter into a contract to build the improvements in accordance with this notice and give bond in the sum of hereinafter provided for the construction of improvements. (Bid bond will be accepted) No bids shall be withdrawn after opening of bids without the consent of the County Supervisors of Burt County, Nebraska for a period of thirty days after scheduled time of closing bids.

Each bidder must be state qualified to submit a proposal for any part or all of the work. All work must be completed according to standard specifications issued by the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads, regarding number and size of rollers, accurate weighing of asphalt loads, paving density, and certified testing laboratory reports on asphalt concrete mix. All fill material must meet state qualifications.

Proposals for this work will be accepted from contractors who are qualified to submit proposals for asphalt concrete work.

The Board of County Supervisors of Burt County, Nebraska reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities in bidding. Bids will be opened at 10:00am in the Boardroom in the courthouse at Tekamah, Nebraska.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a performance bond in the amount of the contract within ten days from the date of award. No additional time will be allowed to contractors for providing the performance bond.

Project to be completed by July 1st, 2017 (weather permitting).
