**SCHOOL BOND ELECTION
BURT COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT 0001
(TEKAMAH-HERMAN PUBLIC SCHOOLS)**

"Shall Burt County School District 11-0001 (Tekamah-Herman Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska be authorized to issue its general obligation bonds in an aggregate stated principal amount not to exceed Twenty-three Million Seven Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$23,760,000), to be issued from time to time, to bear interest at such rate or rates, to be sold at such prices and to become due at such time or times as may be fixed by, or determined at the direction of, the Board of Education, for issuance in connection with a proposed petition and plan titled "Petition and Plan to Dissolve Burt County School District 11-0014 (Oakland-Craig Public Schools), and Burt County School District 11-0001 (Tekamah-Herman Public Schools) and Creating a New School District from the Combined Territory of such Dissolved School Districts",

- To pay a portion of the cost of land acquisition, erecting new school buildings, remodeling of existing facilities and providing necessary furniture and apparatus for said new school buildings and existing facilities, the new school buildings initially to accommodate a 9-12 grade high school program for use in a new combined district described in the proposed petition and plan,
- Such principal amount of bonds reflecting the proportional share of the District's cost of said land acquisition, buildings, improvements, furniture and apparatus based on the taxable valuation of each district described in the proposed petition and plan;
- Provided that such bonds shall not be issued unless Burt County School District 11-0014 (Oakland-Craig Public Schools) is authorized to issue its general obligation bonds for its proportional share of said new school buildings, and the proposed petition and plan shall receive the approvals required by law for the petition and plan to become effective; and

"Shall such School District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the School District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same become due?"

"Shall Burt County School District 11-0014 (Oakland-Craig Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska be authorized to issue its general obligation bonds in an aggregate stated principal amount not to exceed Fourteen Million Seven Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$14,740,000), to be issued from time to time, to bear interest at such rate or rates, to be sold at such prices and to become due at such time or times as may be fixed by, or determined at the direction of, the Board of Education, for issuance in connection with a proposed petition and plan titled "Petition and Plan to Dissolve Burt County School District 11-0014 (Oakland-Craig Public Schools), and Burt County School District 11-0001 (Tekamah-Herman Public Schools) and Creating a New School District from the Combined Territory of such Dissolved School Districts",

- To pay a portion of the cost of land acquisition, erecting new school buildings, remodeling of existing facilities and providing necessary furniture and apparatus for said new school buildings and existing facilities, the new school buildings initially to accommodate a 9-12 grade high school program for use in a new combined district described in the proposed petition and plan,
- Such principal amount of bonds reflecting the proportional share of the District's cost of said land acquisition, buildings, improvements, furniture and apparatus based on the taxable valuation of each district described in the proposed petition and plan;
- Provided that such bonds shall not be issued unless Burt County School District 11-0001 (Tekamah-Herman Public Schools) is authorized to issue its general obligation bonds for its proportional share of said new school buildings, and the proposed petition and plan shall receive the approvals required by law for the petition and plan to become effective; and

"Shall such School District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the School District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same become due?"

**CITY OF TEKAMAH ELECTION
MUNICIPAL AUDITORIUM IMPROVEMENTS**

“Shall the City of Tekamah, Nebraska, issue bonds of said City in the principal amount not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) for the purpose of paying a portion of the cost of constructing improvements to the Municipal Auditorium, providing necessary equipment and furnishings for said Municipal Auditorium, and for other related project costs; said bonds to bear interest at such rate or rates as may be determined by the Mayor and Council of the City and to become due at such time or times as may be fixed by the Mayor and Council, and;

“Shall the City of Tekamah, Nebraska, cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the City sufficient in rate and amount to pay the interest on and principal of said bonds as the same become due?”
