What is it: Supplemental Insurance that provides an additional level of financial protection for yourself and your family in the event of a covered accident or illness. (i.e. an accident, cancer, hospitalization or illness) Aflac provides you help with those costs that may not be covered by your major medical insurance. Aflac pays cash benefits directly to you (unless you specify otherwise), so you can use the cash for anything you want.

Premiums are paid by the employees. This is an OPTIONAL benefit, so you will sign up yourself by contacting the agent listed above. Burt County will set it up to have the premiums taken out of your paycheck.

PLAN YEAR: January-December

ENROLLMENT: Rep will come on-site Nov. or Dec.

- enroll as a new employee, within your first 30 days of employment
- enroll during open enrollment

You can use *Pre-Tax dollars to pay the premiums.

*In order to get 'tax benefits', you must enroll upon employment or during open enrollment.

You *can* enroll throughout the year, but you will NOT get the *tax benefit until the open enrollment period. Your premiums will be paid after your check has already had taxes come out.
