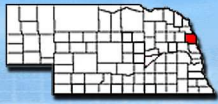

Jordan Arndt and Maddie Hughes, representatives from Zelle Human Resources reported they have met with County Officials and Department Heads and plan to start meeting with staff members today.

**EMERGENCY MANAGER Andrew Donawa -LEOP (Local Emergency Operation Plan):** In Nebraska, each county has a LEOP that is used by local government. The LEOP is focused on an "all hazards" approach to responding to and recovering from a community emergency or natural disaster (CEND) incident. Donawa explained that the County’s current LEOP is outdated and he contacted a consulting firm to help start the process of re-writing Burt County’s LEOP. John Scardena with the firm Doberman Emergency Management, explained the services they offer and options to either assist or to complete an updated plan for the County. The re-write will be done in phases; Doberman Emergency Management

will do phase 1 within FY2021-2022 budget at a cost of \$5,000.00. The remaining work can be decided upon and possibly budgeted in future fiscal years if the County decides to use the firm to complete the project. Two and Three year options were presented:

## ZONING:

Dave Brainard came before the board to discuss his intent to establish a subdivision (Eagle Island Subdivision) within Sections 6-7 Arizona 'N' Township. Ann Chytka, Zoning Administrator explained that Mr. Brainard must obtain permission from the Burt County Board to proceed with his planning. Board Members Swanson and Webster moved for adoption of Resolution 2021-20. By roll call vote: Ayes – Morrow, Swanson, Richards, Pearson, Webster, Connealy and Schold. Nays – none. Resolution was adopted.

### **RESOLUTION #2021-20**

Conditional Use Permit(s) – (4): (1) Chairman Schold opened a Public Hearing at 10:02 a.m. for a conditional use permit for Amber Pallas-Brunt to erect permanent tent structures for glamping and wedding venue at 2865 CoRd I, Tekamah. Amber was present to answer any questions; there was no public comment. Ann Chytka, Burt County Zoning Admin reported that the County Planning commission approved the conditional use permit with conditions that landowner must pull state permits for septic and electric. There was no opposition to the CUP. Chairman Schold declared the public hearing closed at 10:04 A.M., and the Board went back into regular session. Motion was made by Connealy to **approve the Conditional Use Permit**, with the conditions put on from Zoning Board, for Amber Pallas-Brunt for the glamping/wedding venue, Richards seconded and the motion passed with Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Morrow, Swanson, Richards, Pearson, Webster, Connealy and Schold. Nays-none.

At 10:05 A.M. Chairman Schold opened a public hearing for consideration of a (3) Conditional Use Permits for Board of Education Lands – for application of industrial

wastewater sludge at: location (1) Section 17, Township 22N, Range 10E; location (2) Section 8, Township 22N, Range 10E; location (3) Section 23, Township 22N, Range 9E. Ann Chytka, Burt County Zoning Admin explained that the land manager reported to her that they do not plan to stockpile, they do plan on incorporating the materials right away. Chytka reported that the County Planning commission approved the CUP with no conditions. Public Comment: Colby Hansen and David Self (both residents who live in the area) spoke about concerns of the truck traffic from the material being hauled in and concerns of the smell; they would like to see conditions placed on the CUP to address both traffic and smell. Vic Jensen (resident whom also lives in the area) spoke of concerns of the materials not getting incorporated right away and truck traffic. Having no further public comment, the Chairman declared the public hearing closed at 10:22 A.M., and the Board went back into regular session. Motion was made by Morrow to **approve the (3) Conditional Use Permits** for Board of Education Lands with the following (2) conditions; (1) the road department will decide the best route for product delivery and (2) the product be incorporated in as soon as possible. Richards seconded and the motion passed with Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Morrow, Swanson, Richards, Pearson, Webster, Connealy and Schold. Nays-none.

Upon motion by Morrow, seconded by Connealy, the Board gave approval to *DH Events* to obtain a **special designated liquor license** for a member event to be held October 1, 2021 at 88 Tactical in Tekamah. By Roll Call Vote: Ayes -Morrow, Swanson, Richards, Pearson, Webster, Connealy and Schold. Nays-none.

Chairman Schold signed approval form for Oakland Golf Club to submit liquor control commission paperwork to register their new Corporate Manager Andrew Smeal. County Board approval was upon motions by Swanson and Pearson. By Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Morrow, Swanson, Richards, Pearson, Webster, Connealy and Schold. Nays- none.

*Board of Equalization:* No meeting was held, just noted for record: Real Property Exemptions (2021) will be published this month and will be reported to the Nebraska Department of Revenue per § 77-202.03(5).

The notice of budget hearing and budget summary were published in the Plaindealer (9-7-2021), upon a 1<sup>st</sup> floor bulletin board within the courthouse and on the County's Website. A copy of the proof of publication is on file in the office of the County Clerk. The following members were present: David Schold, Cliff Morrow, Gary "Bird" Swanson, Paul Richards, Carl Pearson, Dale Webster and Ted Connealy.

The meeting opened at 10:34 A.M. Chairman Schold informed the public that the Open Meeting Act is posted on the wall.

Chairman Schold declared a Public Hearing open at 10:34 A.M., for the purpose of hearing support, opposition, criticism, suggestions or observations of taxpayers relating to setting the final tax request (FY 2021-2022) at a different amount than the prior year tax request. It was noted that the tax request is down \$298,877.00. There was no public comment. At 10:36 A.M. Chairman closed the hearing, and the board returned to regular session.

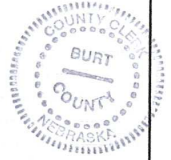

Application for a **Commercial Renovation Grant**: The application is from Studio Sheets for new front door, new shingles on the awning, and paint on the South side of 324 S. 13<sup>th</sup> St, Tekamah. Patty Plugge, Burt County Economic Development, reported that the BCEDC board had approved the request for all projects; however, since their board’s approval the owner reported that they just want to proceed with only the door at this time. The Burt County Board approved the release of \$989.45 from County Fund 0900; this is 50% of low bid for the door only. Approved upon motion by Pearson, seconded by Morrow. By roll call vote: Ayes – Morrow, Swanson, Richards, Pearson, Webster, Connealy and Schold. Nays – none.

*Public Comment:* Bill Price, 1615 CoRd. 10, had 2 main comments (a) Presented a question of depths mentioned for decommissioning solar vs wind; he stated that our regs. show decommissioning solar to be minimum depth of 10 ft. below grade and documents from Bromm Law that the County is considering shows decommissioning wind to be minimum depth of 4 ft. below grade. (b) He shared a handout about Ohio Senate Bill 52; according to Buckeye Farm News, Aug. 2021, 'SB52 gives county commissioners new authority to decide on which areas within their jurisdiction solar and wind development can take place.' Mr. Price reported that he shared this with State Senator Ben Hansen and encouraged him to consider supporting Legislation that would allow this authority to Nebraska County Boards.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, the meeting adjourned at 11:13 A.M. upon motions by Connealy and Morrow.
