The Burt County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, October 11, 2022 in the County Boardroom on the 2nd floor of the Burt County Courthouse in Tekamah, Nebraska, pursuant to adjournment of their last meeting. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by Publication in the Lyons Mirror-Sun (10-6-2022), upon a 1st floor bulletin board within the courthouse and on the County's Website. A copy of the proof of publication is on file in the office of the County Clerk. The following members were present: David Schold, Kevin P. The meeting opened at 9:00 A.M. with the pledge of Allegiance. Chairman Schold informed the public that the Open Meeting Act is posted on the wall.

Board of Equalization

Extension Office:

Vehicle: Luan Oliviera, from the Burt County Extension office informed the board of vehicle trouble they are having with their current extension vehicle (2013 Ford Flex). The computer is showing a code for the catalytic converter; however, their office only has \$3,500.00 left in the vehicle repair line. The board instructed to obtain two estimates, and then go ahead and proceed with the needed repairs on the vehicle at this time.

Staffing: Luan stated that Stacey Keys has completed her probationary period; he will bring

Maximus:

Upon motion by Connealy, seconded by Pearson, the Board authorized Chairman Schold to sign a contract with Maximus US Services, Inc. to prepare a Cost Allocation Plan for actual FY data 2022-2023-2024. Approved By Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Tobin, Swanson, Richards, Pearson, Webster, Connealy and Schold. Nays - none.

Grant Funds - (LATCF) Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Fund:

NACO shared the opportunity for Counties to apply for the federal funds via this program; the intent of the LATCF is support to counties with federal lands within their jurisdictions. Burt County is eligible for two \$50,000.00 payments (FY 2022 and 2023); annual Federal reporting will be required until the funds are expended. The board asked County Clerk Sarah J. Freidel to proceed with applying for the funds.

PUBLIC COMMENT (2): (1) Donette Jackson – requested the County send a copy of Resolution 2022-18 to Senator Fischer’s office to be placed on file as opposition to ‘30x30’ President Biden’s Executive Order 14008 signed Jan. 27, 2021. * The board instructed County Clerk to do this; Clerk Freidel confirmed she would mail it yet today. *(2) Frederick C. Schmidt* – made a complaint about treatment he received from Sheriff Deputy KC Bang while reporting an incident he had; Schmidt asked the board to review a video of the interaction.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, the meeting adjourned at 9:44 A.M. upon motions by Connealy and Webster.
